

STUDENTMOVETO 2019 DATA USE GUIDELINES/ AGREEMENT

StudentMoveTO is a collaborative partnership between ten colleges and universities, and four government and community organizations in the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA), Canada, with a goal of better understanding post-secondary students' transportation needs and challenges. The research program is supported by a Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC) grant.

In fall 2019, a large student transportation survey was conducted (StudentMoveTO 2019). More than 18,500 students from 10 GTHA-area universities and colleges participated in the survey who provided socio-demographic information, travel related attitudes/ perceptions, as well as data on campus participation and subjective wellbeing. Participants also filled out a one-day travel diary where they reported all commute and non-commute trips, travel modes used, and destinations of these trips.

Recognizing the value of this data in generating insights, debates, and actions to improve transportation experiences of post-secondary students and the broader population, the StudentMoveTO team is pleased to share the data with researchers, students, academic institutions, planners/ policy makers, advocates and other interested citizens, on a request-to-download basis.

1. Public Use

Anonymized data, with detailed locations masked to maintain confidentiality, is available to everyone for research, educational and planning purposes.

The data can be freely used by individuals, institutions and agencies for the abovementioned purposes. For-profit organizations can use the data to inform planning reports.

The following conditions MUST be met when using the data:

- 1.1) The data can be shared with others within the same organization without any prior permission from the StudentMoveTO team. However, StudentMoveTO data (or any modified version of the data) cannot be shared or used for commercial purposes. Use of the data to inform planning or consulting reports is an acceptable use.
